













Lord's Supper Sundays: Celebration of the Gospel

- First Sunday of each month (usually)
- Focus is on one part of the Gospel each time (2 cycles each year)
 - 1. The Holy God: all powerful creator of all that is
 - 2. Sinful people:
 - when you and I disobey what we know is right
 - when we ignore what God is saying
 - when we don't choose to put Him first
 - **3. Our Saving God**: He wills (Father), enacts (Son), and applies (Spirit) our rescue from our sin and declared to be as good and righteous as the Son
 - 4. Faith: our humble agreement with, hope in, and submission to 1, 2, 3
 - 5. Mission: our "living into" what God has done
 - being God's children who live like He lives
 - 6. Glory: God welcoming us into His home in glory forever

The Letter to the Ephesian Church

- Letter to the church in Ephesus (modern Turkey)
- God's overall purpose
 - "to bring unity to all things in heaven and on earth under Christ." *Ephesians 1:10*
- Implications for the church: How do we fit into that purpose?




Our Calling (vocation) - Ephesians 2:19-22

Consequently, you are no longer foreigners and strangers, but fellow citizens with God's people and also **members of his household**, built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus himself as the chief cornerstone. In him the whole building is joined together and rises to become **a holy temple in the Lord**. And in him you too are being **built together** to become **a dwelling in which God lives by his Spirit**.

We are a holy temple in which God lives!


- 1-6: Since the church is called to be a dwelling place for the one God by His Spirit, let us eagerly pursue unity

- 11-13: He gave church-equipping gifts to some so that all His people would do the work of the ministry
- 14-16: Result: the church matures into God's purpose: a dwelling place for God by His Spirit <u>as all work</u>


The Big Idea
