

- Prayer: we want to hear God speak





The Lord's Supper

- A celebration of Jesus' death in our place to bring us life
- For us: First Sunday of each month
- Each time, we focus on one part of the Gospel
 - 1. God is the good creator of all that is
 - 2. Sin dishonors God, breaks relationships with God, others, and self
 - 3. Jesus took that sin & consequences on Himself to rescue us
 - 4. We receive His rescue by faith in Him (submitting self to Him)
 - 5. In submitting to Christ, we are called to obey Him
 - 6. One day, He will make all things good, just, life-giving


Hebrew View of having a Homeland

- Blessings of having your own land
 - Security, justice, provision from generation to generation
 - Freedom to live according to own values
- Living away from homeland
 - Pilgrim: traveler
 - Sojourner (temporary stay) or Stranger (long stay)
 - Exile: banished from homeland
- Issues when away from homeland
 - Don't have the blessings of home
 - Conflict of values: misunderstood or judged as "strange"
 - Experience rejection: persecution



Trials

- Living in "poverty" when the "wealth of heaven" is ours
 - Continued experience of temptation and sin
 - Continued experience of a decaying body & world
 - Continued experience of others' sin
 - Seeing God "through a mirror dimly" rather than face to face
- Living by different values than society
- Sometimes being rejected by people


The Big Idea

Application

- Don't be enslaved by present "riches"
 whether you have them or not
 - Sometimes we want the riches of this world more than we want the riches of God's inheritance
 - This world's riches will ALWAYS disappoint and decay
 - God promises far greater riches that will deeply satisfy and will grow in glory forever

- Don't be defined by present troubles
 - Compared to the unending glory and blessings of God's presence, current troubles are light and momentary

Application
