 - Peter didn't find faith
 - 8: Peter called for faith

9-10:

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8: The man rejoices, leaping to the praise of God
• 7 verbs → he was actively praising!

9-10:

Isaiah 35:4-7, 10: Predicting Jesus' coming

Say to those with fearful hearts, "Be strong, do not fear: God's Messiah (Jesus) God's people by the Holy Spirit

your God will come, he will come

with vengeance; with divine retribution **he will come** to save you." The burning sand will become a pool, the thirsty ground bubbling springs. In the haunts where jackals once lay, grass and reeds and papyrus will grow.

Then will the eyes of the blind be opened and the ears of the deaf unstopped.
Then will **the lame leap like a deer**, and the mute tongue shout for joy.
Water will gush forth in the wilderness and streams in the desert. They will enter Zion with **singing**; everlasting joy will crown their heads. Gladness and joy will overtake them, and sorrow and sighing will flee away.

• What impressed them: man with a lifelong disability & without hope, now walking and praising God

- Finding that there is a cure if given the right medicine
 - Yet that hospital doesn't actually use medicine
 - They just talk about it
