What would it be like to be in the presence of the _____ person ever?

Conversations about Greatness in Mark 10

_____ → seemingly not great at all

People brought children to Jesus to be blessed by Him. The disciples rebuked them. Jesus rebuked the disciples:

“Anyone who will not receive the kingdom of God like a little child will never enter it.” verse 18

_____ and _____ man → seemingly very great

A rich and good man wanted to follow Jesus, yet left Jesus sadly because his money was more important. The disciples were amazed that such a good man would miss out. Jesus replied:

“How hard it is for the rich to enter the kingdom of God!” verse 23

_____ → seeking greatness

James and John (apostles) asked for seats of honor in Jesus' new kingdom. The other disciples were upset by this.

“Whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant, and whoever wants to be first must be slave of all.” verses 43-44

_____ → the greatest possible being
