Conviction: knowledge that shapes my life






# What is the actual, bodily resurrection of Jesus Christ for you?

## Application

- Believe that Jesus rose bodily from the dead
  - Even first-hand witnesses struggled to believe!
    - It was a miracle = an act of God
    - Miracles always require faith
    - Yet it is the most reasonable explanation of the facts
  - The road to faith can be a journey
  - So keep taking steps toward faith
  - If you sense something different in the presence of God's people, maybe it is like 'our hearts burning within us'
    - God is still working. Don't miss Him!

## Application

- Believe that Jesus rose bodily from the dead
- Be lighted by the conviction of the resurrection
  - The resurrection means that what happens after death is far more important than what happens before death
    - Death is NOT the end
    - Acceptance by God in Christ is worth so much more than...
      - People's praise and approval and care for you...
      - Money, success, degrees, and tenure and ...
      - Pleasure, comfort, "self fulfillment" in this life
  - The gift of the Spirit today gives true meaning to any experiences and struggles we have in this life

## Application

- Believe that Jesus rose bodily from the dead
- Be lighted by the conviction of the resurrection
- Joyfully worship our risen Lord
  - Our God took our suffering, shame, and trouble as if it were His own, and gave us forgiveness
  - Our God turned us from being enemies of God and made us deeply loved children of God in Christ
    - If you turn to Christ, you (mind, soul, and body) are ransomed and adopted by the King of all Kings!

## Application

- Believe that Jesus rose bodily from the dead
- Be lighted by the conviction of the resurrection
- Joyfully worship our risen Lord
- Tell people about our risen Lord
  - This good news must be told!
  - God's plan: repentance for forgiveness in Jesus' name is for the peoples of every nation
  - So be His witnesses, both near and far
  - By the power of the Holy Spirit
