Looking for help...

- We cannot escape the 'gravity' that pulls us down
- So we try to find something powerful enough to help
 - Much of the world and most of the people of history
 - Find the **gods** or **spirits** that have the right power in the right place to help, and pray to them/worship them/sacrifice to them
 - "Modern" world
 - Find the right **technology** or **technique** to help
 - Postmodern world
 - Become cynical
 - Don't hope for ultimate meaning or answers or rescue

The Bible describes something fundamentally different

Romans 6:3-5

Jesus was perfect, Don't you know that all of us who were baptized yet was cursed into Christ Jesus were baptized into his **death**? in death for us

We were therefore buried with him through baptism into **death** in order that, just as Christ was raised from the **dead** through the glory of the Father, life in full victory we too may **live** a new **life**. over sin and death

For if we have been united with him in a **death** like his, we will certainly also be united with him in a **resurrection** like his.

We are united with Jesus in His death to sin, and in His rising to life

The Big Idea

Becoming a Christian

is leaving the kingdom of death and decay through "death" with Jesus

and entering the **Kingdom of Life and Light**through resurrection with Jesus by the glory of God

Jesus died in the curse of death

Jesus rose again to a glorious life, destroying the power of death

Jesus opened the way for us to leave the kingdom of death and decay and enter the Kingdom of Life and Light with Him and through Him
