The story of Abraham

- The beginning of God's specific plan of rescuing humanity
- God's command to Abraham:
 - "Go to a new land that I'll give to your descendants
 - but not to you
 - I'll explain later"
- Abraham obeyed and went
 - He never owned any land there
 - except a burial plot

Abraham

- His son Isaac and grandson Jacob lived the same way
- After that, the family lived as strangers in a foreign country (Egypt) for 400 years

- As slaves

Then God brought them back to the Land of Promise
 – 500 years after the promise was given



Hebrews 11:8-10 By faith Abraham, when called to go to a place he would later receive as his inheritance, obeyed and went, even though he did not know where he was going. By faith he made his home in the promised land like a stranger in a foreign country; he lived in tents, as did Isaac and Jacob, who were heirs with him of the same promise.
