


### Psalm 27

1-3: The Lord is the stronghold of my life

- 4-6: Many different words for what threatens me
- 7-12: Wicked, enemies, foes, army, war, wild animals
- 13-14: Poetry: refers to whatever makes me insecure
  - Irony:
    - God is so great that my enemies who try to trip me are the ones who stumble and fall
  - God protects in the extreme cases
    - Evil people seeking to devour me
    - Even a whole army or a whole war is against me!
  - So God protects me from lesser things too

### Psalm 27


1-3: The Lord is the stronghold of my life

4-6: Hope and joy are found in the presence of God

7-12: "Hear my voice when I call, Lord"

- 13-14: Active pursuit of God's presence
  - Call out, seeking His face (personal connection)
  - Request: teach me, lead me
    - Commitment to take action in obedience
  - Confidence in God's compassion and care
    - Even beyond the compassion and care from parents


# Psalm 27

What, then, shall we say in response to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all—how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things? Who will bring any charge against those whom God has chosen? ### As it is written:


"For your sake we face death all day long; we are considered as sheep to be slaughtered."
