





- My biggest problem is **my** sin and brokenness
- Every good action must begin with the recognition that I am part of the problem
  - Jesus: "First, remove the log from your own eye..."
  - I will answer to God first for my sin and brokenness
  - Then for those hurt my sin and brokenness
