- The 4 Gospels: Matthew / Mark / Luke / John

The Gospel according to Matthew

- Matthew: A disciple of Jesus
- Jesus is the Messiah (God's chosen messenger & hero) who brought the Kingdom of God to earth

Leading up to the climax in Matthew

- Jesus birth, teaching (5 major teaching sections), good works/miracles, and death
- Resurrection: His appearance to the women with instructions to disciples: "meet me in Galilee"
- Soldiers and Jewish leaders witnessed the resurrection
 and opposed it




