
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# Isaiah's context & prophecy

conquered Isaiah predicted that the rest of Israel would also be conquered Dark days ("death darkness") were coming for the people of God

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## Without hope in God, darkness and fearful gloom will come

When someone tells you to consult mediums and spiritists, who whisper and mutter, should not a people inquire of their God? Why consult the dead on behalf of the living? Consult God's instruction and the testimony of warning. If anyone does not speak according to this word, they have **no light of dawn**. - •God's glory is more than an octillion times greater than any other glory and goodness!
- •Pain and trouble are still real
  - Yet they are never the whole truth about us
  - And they are never the fundamental or final truth about us
- •Even our sin and rebellion do not stop His glory!
  - When we turn to Jesus, longing to be freed from our sin and rebellion, nothing can stop this blindingly great glory of God from sweeping over us
