

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

Encounters with Jesus in Luke 7 Centurion's faith: "I have not found such great faith even in Israel." -His servant was healed POWERFUL! Crowd when Jesus raised the widow's only son: NOT CLEAR... -"A great prophet has appeared among us." John the Baptist's struggling question: "Are you the one?" NOT TOLD... -Jesus: "Blessed is anyone who does not stumble on account of me." Pharisees and experts of God's law NO EFFECT ... -rejected God's purpose for themselves Sinful woman who washed Jesus' feet: POWERFUL! -"Your faith has saved you; go in peace." Simon who watched this woman's transformation: -he loved Jesus little NO EFFECT ...

#### Luke 8:1-3

After this, Jesus traveled about from one town and village to another, proclaiming the good news of the kingdom of God. The <u>Twelve</u> were with him, and also some women who had been cured of evil spirits and diseases: Mary (called Magdalene) from whom seven demons had come out; Joanna the wife of Chuza, the manager of Herod's household; Susanna; and many others. These women were helping to support them out of their own means.

Twelve = the Apostles whom Jesus appointed

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#### Luke 8:4-8

While a large crowd was gathering and people were coming to Jesus from town after town, he told this parable: "A farmer went out to sow his seed. As he was scattering the seed, some fell along the path; it was trampled on, and the birds ate it up. Some fell on rocky ground, and when it came up, the plants withered because they had no moisture. Other seed fell among thorns, which grew up with it and choked the plants. Still other seed fell on good soil. It came up and <u>yielded a crop</u>, a hundred times more than was sown."

When he said this, he called out, "Whoever has ears to hear, let them hear."

yielded a crop = produced fruit

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His disciples asked him what this <u>parable</u> meant.

He said, "The knowledge of the secrets of the kingdom of God has been given to you, but to others I speak in <u>parables</u>, so that,

Luke 8:9-10

parable = an ordinary event with a deeper meaning

#### Luke 8:11-15

"This is the meaning of the parable: The seed is the word of God. Those along the <u>path</u> are the ones who hear, and then the devil comes and takes away the word from their hearts, so that they may not believe and be saved. Those on the <u>rocky ground</u> are the ones who receive the word with joy when they hear it, but they have no root. They believe for a while, but in the time of testing they fall away. The seed that fell among thorns stands for those who hear, but as they go on their way they are choked by life's worries, riches and pleasures, and they do not mature. But the seed on <u>good soil</u> stands for those with a noble and good heart, who hear the word, retain it, and by persevering produce a crop.

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Twelve = the Apostles whom Jesus appointed

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#### Luke 8:1-15

1-3: The Twelve (men) and many women are with Jesus

- In that day:
  - Not unusual for women to have control of money and to give it to a teacher
  - What was radical (even scandalous): for women to be among the disciples
    - being disciples → learning from Jesus with Jesus
    - traveling in an unrelated mixed group
- Women: emphasis on transformation & generosity
  - Mary & Joanna also mentioned at the cross
  - Joanna had social and financial power
- 9-10: They are presented as ideal disciples
- 1-15: The only pattern: all kinds of people joined Jesus

# 4-8: Jesus teaches the large crowd a parable: seeds in soil

- Perhaps Jesus and the disciples had invited people to this event (town after town)
- Jesus decides to teach the large crowd through a 'narrative analogy' that must be 'unwrapped'
- Common experience: scatter seed, then plow it in
  - Path: land animals and birds prevent any growth
  - Rock: lack moisture, so it withers
  - **Thorns**: choked, so fruit doesn't mature
- 9-10: **Good soil**: abundantly fruitful
- 11-15: Jesus' command: **learn from this story!**

He said, "The knowledge of the secrets of the kingdom of God has been given to you, but to others I speak in parables, so that,

'though seeing, they may not see; though hearing, they may not understand.'

# 9-10: Disciples ask for help. Jesus: not everyone gets answers

- A combination of the Twelve and women
  - like Mary listening at Jesus' feet
- They take Jesus' command seriously → Ask for help
- This is Jesus' answer (not an aside)
  - Only some benefit from Jesus' teaching ('secrets')
    - Power and blessing of God's Word
    - Knowledge and experience of the Kingdom of God
    - Yet for some, it is just a story
- 11-15: This variable benefit is by God's design  $\rightarrow$  a puzzle

#### Luke 8:11-15

"This is the meaning of the parable: The seed is the word of God. Those along the <u>path</u> are the ones who hear, and then the devil comes and takes away the word from their hearts, so that they may not believe and be saved. The seed that fell among thorns stands for those who hear, but as they go on their way they are choked by <u>life's worries</u>, riches and pleasures, and they do not mature. # 11-15: Fruit from God's seed only comes in 'good soil'

- What happens when people encounter God's Word?
  - Path: the devil works to stop the Word of God
  - Rock: "time of testing" stops people
  - **Thorns**: "**life**" gets in the way
  - **Good soil**: they hear, retain, and persevere
    - Not path \improx hold on to the Word (hold tight!)
    - Not rock hold fast in trouble, don't let go
    - Not thorns **→** stay focused on it in life
    - Generate good and abundant fruit!

# Be convinced: God works through His Word

• "The seed is the word of God" Luke 8:11

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• The Seed=The work of God communicated and enacted in our hearts through the Word of God by the Spirit of God

**Blessed** is the one who does not walk in step with the wicked or stand in the way that sinners take or sit in the company of mockers, but

whose delight is in the <u>law of the Lord</u>, and who meditates on his law day and night.

That person is like a tree planted by streams of water, which **yields its fruit** in season and whose leaf does not wither—whatever they do **prospers**.

- It takes faith: hearing the Word of God without faith does not bring the fruit of God
- It takes courage: God's Word is powerful, and it will do a powerful work in 'good and noble' hearts

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# Serotiny: Cones of the Jack Pine Tree

Seeds that are only released by a fire Resin seals the seeds The resin needs high heat to melt Some then need one or more wet-dry cycles to release the seeds

In the same way, some of God's seeds are fruitful only over time and after trials

It is critical to persevere!

Yet the devil, and difficulties, and the distractions of life often stop the process





Without the Word of God, we live a flat existence

We miss the genuine relationship with the God who created us, loves us, and has come to rescue us

The Word of God brings 3D life!

Yet engaging the Word of God brings some challenges!

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Exploring the Word with our minds can be puzzling, or confusing

It can be offensive

It can seemingly claim what seemingly cannot be true

Yet exploring the Word brings deeper understanding of ourselves, each other, and our world



Digging into the Word with our hearts can bring some frightening things about us to light!

It can show us things that bring grief and shame and even fear

Yet digging into the Word brings life to our lifeless hearts

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Engaging the Word with our bodies can stretch muscles we didn't know we had!

It can call us to go places and do things that are frightening or very challenging or risky

Yet engaging the Word also brings purpose and value to our physical being



Engaging God's Word with our whole being is stretching!

Engaging God's Word adds depth to our being

Engaging God's Word brings deep joy to life!

Engaging God's Word takes courage and faith!!

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# The Big Idea

The blessing of encountering Jesus comes to those who hear and hold tightly His Word and persevere in following Him with courage and faith

When Jesus had taught these things, he called out, "Whoever has ears to hear, let them hear."
