### Jerusalem, the Temple, and Passover

#### Jerusalem

- The epicenter of Jewish life: social, political, economic, and religious
- "The city of our God, the Great King" *Psalms 48:1-2*

#### The Temple

- The epicenter of Jerusalem, especially religiously

#### Passover

- One of the 3 great feasts (perhaps the greatest)

#### Jerusalem at Passover

- Those who could travel to Jerusalem at Passover would
- Perhaps normal population: 30,000
- Perhaps at Passover: 180,000
- The Temple is the center of the Passover

### Jerusalem, the Temple, and Passover → Jesus

#### Traveling to Jerusalem for the Passover

- Now on the last leg of the journey: Jericho to Jerusalem

#### With...

- The 12 apostles
- Many more disciples (including the prominent women)
- The mother of 2 of the 12, so probably other relatives...
- And a "great crowd"

As they approached Jerusalem and came to Bethphage on the Mount of Olives, Jesus sent two disciples, saying to them, “Go to the village ahead of you, and at once you will find a donkey tied there, with her colt by her. Untie them and bring them to me. If anyone says anything to you, say that the Lord needs them, and he will send them right away.”

This took place to fulfill what was spoken through the prophet:

“Say to Daughter Zion,

  - Probably the people who called for His crucifixion
  - “STIRRED” is the same word as “the earth SHOOK” when Jesus died and “the guards TREMBLED” when the angels rolled the stone away from Jesus’ tomb
- “Who is this?” is an objection rather than seeking information
- Galilean crowds were right, yet incomplete

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### Stop the Spread of Germs

Help prevent the spread of respiratory diseases like COVID-19.

Stay at least 6 feet (about 2 arm lengths) from other people.
