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
Everyone is but a breath, even those who seem secure.

- Chapter 3: in human experience "Everything is frustratingly out of our control"

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Ecclesiastes 3:10-11

¹⁰ I have seen the burden God has laid on the human race. ¹¹ He has made everything beautiful in its time. He has also set eternity in the human heart; yet no one can fathom what God has done from beginning to end.

An awareness of time without the power to understand it or control it is a heavy burden from God



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God has set eternity in the human heart but no one can figure it out

- •We know...
 - there is a bigger picture than here and now
 - and we are connected to it
 - and there are appropriate times for things
- Dogs & cats & the other animals...
 - don't regret the past
 - don't worry about the future
- The past & future often dominate our present
 - •We can't fix the past
 - ·We can't be sure what is right in the present
 - We can't know the future So we struggle

The story of humanity

- Humans are made in the image of God
 - Made for eternity
 Peace (Shalom) with
 - In the Garden of Eden: Tree of Life eternity
- Sin/rebellion spoiled the good design
 - Humanity expelled from the Garden of Eden
 - No more access to the Tree of Life
- New Heaven & New Earth through Jesus
 - Abundant, monthly crops from Tree of Life for all who live there

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Ecclesiastes 3:12-13

¹² I know that there is nothing better for people than to be happy and to do good while they live.

Without eternity (the Tree of Life)...
Resignation, not enthusiasm
Better to ignore time
and seek happiness in the moment
Yet God controls that too

¹⁴ I know that everything God does will endure forever; nothing can be added to it and nothing taken from it. God does it so that people will fear him.

Whatever is has already been, and what will be has been before; and God will call the past to account.

2 Timothy 1:9-10


The Big Idea

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Application #1

Admit our time problem

- We want eternity, but can't reach it
- We can't determine the times
 - •Birth $\leftarrow \rightarrow$ Death
 - Is it time for grace or severity?
- Yet we keep trying! [as if we could]
 - Rehearsing the past
 - Fearing the future
 - Worrying what is appropriate for today
- Or we just give up and live for today
- ·We need help!

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Application #2

Find eternity in God

- He can work the past together for good
