
Is it enough?

Ecclesiastes 9:13-16

¹³ I also saw under the sun this example of wisdom that greatly impressed me: ¹⁴ There was once a small city with only a few people in it. And a powerful king came against it, surrounded it and built huge siege works against it. ¹⁵ Now there lived in that city a man poor but wise, and he saved the city by his wisdom. But nobody remembered that poor man. ¹⁶ So I said, "Wisdom is better than strength."

But the poor man's wisdom is despised, and his words are no longer heeded.


⁵ There is an evil I have seen under the sun, the sort of error that arises from a ruler:


Escaping Gravity

Application

Admit the problem of decay in EVERYTHING

- Death: the natural decay of everything
- Sin: decay of the human heart
- Affects our bodies, our relationships, our souls
- There is no human or natural solution!

Application

Admit the problem of decay in EVERYTHING Trust in Jesus Christ: His death and resurrection

- The only One who has conquered sin and death
- Jesus Christ solved the unsolvable!
- "The old order of things has passed away.
 He who was seated on the throne said,
 "I am making everything new!"" Revelation 21:4-5
- Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!" 2 Corinthians 5:17
