God's purpose in salvation is to form one new humanity drawn from all peoples to be one new house for God



Humbly pursue boldness

"And if the ear should say, 'Because I am not an eye, I do not belong to the body,' it would not for that reason stop being part of the body. ... But in fact God has placed the parts in the body, every one of them, just as he wanted them to be." 1 Corinthians 12:16, 18

Learn to be more humble while also boldly being who God has made us to be
