


#### John 1:1-5

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. <sup>2</sup> He was with God in the beginning. <sup>3</sup> Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made. <sup>4</sup> In him was life, and that life was the light of all mankind. <sup>5</sup> The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it. The Word is Jesus Christ, the Son of God The Word is in perfect fellowship with the Father

The Word is God just as the Father is God

#### John 1:6-8

<sup>6</sup> There was a man sent from God whose name was John. <sup>7</sup> He came as a witness to testify concerning that light, so that through him all might believe. <sup>8</sup> He himself was not the light; he came only as a witness to the light.

God sent a human witness (John) to point to the Son of God in human form

God continues to send human witnesses "that all might believe"

#### John 1:14

<sup>14</sup> The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.

The Son has always been and always will be God The Son became a human being He brought God's glory, grace, and truth into the world

## John 1:15

<sup>15</sup> (John testified concerning him. He cried out, saying, "This is the one I spoke about when I said, 'He who comes after me has surpassed me because he was before me.")

John was a witness that Jesus is the Son of God

#### John 1:16-18

<sup>16</sup> Out of his fullness we have all received grace in place of grace already given. <sup>17</sup> For the law was given through Moses; grace and truth came through Jesus Christ. <sup>18</sup> No one has ever seen God, but the one and only Son, who is himself God and is in closest relationship with the Father, has made him known.

The Word makes God the Father known and experienced → His glory, grace, and truth → Most clearly seen in the cross






Being a Christian




which He gives to all who receive Jesus Christ














Having true Life and Glory that forever grows is by God giving Life more glorious as we receive/believe in Jesus Christ

To those who do, He gives the unending and glorious life of God




#### Find new life in Jesus, the Son of God


